Entries are invited for the 8th Dance Competition to be held in February 2017. The competition, open to boys and girls, will be conducted as per details given below. Entries will close at 8.00 p.m. on 31st December 2016. Age limit implies completed years as on closing date.

1.	Group I Junior Group (Age 10-15 years)	7 minutes	The performance should contain both nritta and abhinaya aspects in classical Bharatanatyam (Film songs will not be allowed)
2.	Group II Senior Group (Age 15-20 years)	12 minutes	The performance should contain both nritta and abhinaya aspects in classical Bharatanatyam (Film songs will not be allowed)

COMPETITION RULES

Please study the rules before filling the form for the competition

- 1. This competition is open for amateurs only (for non-professionals and non-television artists).
- 2. A competitor found to be over / below the prescribed age for the group applied for, will be considered ineligible for competition. **The proof of age should be attached with the application form**. The qualifying date of birth for each competitor will be his / her age as on 31-12-2016.
- A non-refundable entrance fee of Rs. 100/- in cash or Demand Draft favouring "Sri Shanmukhananda Fine Arts & Sangeetha Sabha" should be sent along with the entry form.
- 4. Recorded music is permitted. Candidates will have to arrange their own CD / Tape players for playing music. However, if needed, candidates may make their own arrangement of musicians at their own cost. The audio quality of the music should be good and clear.
- Candidates will appear for the competition in appropriate practice dress. THEY SHOULD NOT COME WITH FULL COSTUME / HEAVY MAKE-UP.
- 6. The number of prizes awarded will depend on the quality and quantity of entries and will be at the discretion of the Managing Committee. There should be a minimum of 3 entries per category. Should there be less, the competition will still be conducted and the prizes awarded to those who score above 70%.
- Candidates should report half an hour before the scheduled time. No accommodation will be provided nor travelling expenses paid to outstation candidates.
- 8. Decision of the judges will be final and binding.
- 9. Competitors will be intimated in writing regarding the date and time of the competition.

ENTRIES WILL CLOSE at 8.00 p.m. on 31st DECEMBER 2016.
